The VAD students were taught to draw different human body gesture and facial expression by drawing markers. Their marker drawing skills were improving constantly.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 15 sessions of animation course were organized for the S5 VAD students in July to September 2019. The computer graphic and animation skills were taught in 5 sessions, while 10 sessions of individual tutorials were organized to enable students to refine their artwork. 100% of the participants achieved 90% or above attendance rate in the animation course. Animations of diverse themes were produced with considerable quality. • The students' feedback towards the enrichment courses was positive. According to the students' questionnaires, all participants of both marker illustration class and animation class agreed that the courses could enrich their abilities in art making. 100% participants agreed the marker illustration class and animation class could enhance their abilities in art appreciation, as well as their interests of art making.
